CRIMP BEADS

Economy crimps are the smallest and least expensive option available, but are fairly weak and can break easily. They are appropriate for spacing beads along jeweler’s wire, and for finishing light, inexpensive projects. Best quality are slightly larger, lightly ribbed, and much stronger. Crimps are available in nickel (N), gold (GP) silver (SP) gunmetal (G35) and copper (CU) finishes. Note: When using base metal crimp beads, always use two, side-by-side at each end of your work – this is much stronger and more reliable than just one. Sizes given are for closest outside measurement, not inside diameter, and quantities are approximate, as crimp beads are packaged by weight.

EARRING FINDINGS

Hooks: Note for metal sensitive people: Most surgical steel has nickel in it; therefore, if you are nickel sensitive you should use either titanium or nickel free stainless steel, of which we have a limited line of findings. For those who are super sensitive, we have plastic spring hooks, sterling silver (SS), and 10Kt gold filled (GF) ear hardware, noted in a separate section.

The selection shown here includes only the most popular items – we do have a few other options available in store, including titanium hooks, plastic backs, a wide variety of clip-on findings and filigree posts. Please call for descriptions and prices.

Spring Hooks: silver and gold plated spring hooks are plated over surgical steel for increased strength and reduced allergenicity. Available in nickel-free surgical steel (NNSUS), Surgical steel with a gold coloured ball and coil (YSUS) gold and silver plated over surgical steel (GPSUS and SPSUS respectively).

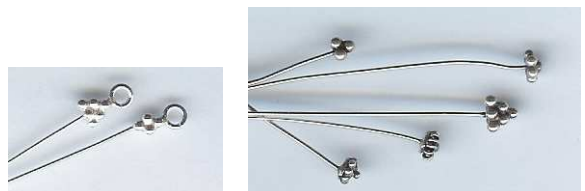

Instead, knot with a reef knot or two-strand overhand knot, and fix the knot with glue or nail hardener before cutting excess cord). Silk stretch cord is a fibrous, silky cord, high stretch but prone to fraying. Opelon is a stretch jewelry fiber of the same texture as Silk stretch cord, but higher durability. Items threaded on elastic should be restrung on a regular basis (depending on how often worn) to avoid accidental breakage and loss of beads.

Jeweler's wire is composed of stainless steel cables, twisted and sheathed in a nylon coating. It is strong and flexible, and used with small, hollow metal beads called crimps, that are squished to hold the wire in place. Quality ranges quite a bit: the greater the number of strands in jeweler's wire, the stronger it is. Higher quality jeweler's wire is also more flexible and soft to touch. For beginners and light projects, 3 or 7 strand works just fine – 7 strand Acculon and Beadalon are our most popular types. For heavier glass or semi-precious stringing, a higher strand count and quality is recommended. For optimum strength, use the largest diameter wire that will fit through your beads – glass, plastic, metal, bone or wood beads often have larger holes than semi-precious stones and crystals, which in turn have larger holes than freshwater pearls.

When measuring a piece, add enough extra jeweler's wire at each end to allow for finishing – usually two inches at each end is sufficient, so measure a piece four inches longer than the desired final length. Leaving the clasp attachment until the last moment (use tape, alligator clips or another form of ingenuity so your beads don't go on one end and off the other!) allows for adjustment on either end of a project, without the need to entirely re-string if one side or the other is too long or too short.

Once the project is strung, the jeweler's wire should be threaded through the crimp bead (two recommended if not sterling or gold filled, as two side by side are MUCH stronger than just one) then through the base loop of the chosen clasp, and back through the crimp beads. If possible, thread about an inch of the jeweler's wire back through the strung beads, as well... hiding the end will ensure that, once excess wire is cut off (as close as possible, with wire cutters), there are no wire ends poking out to cause discomfort. The loop through the base of the clasp should be large enough that the clasp can move freely; if the loop is too tight, stress on the clasp may create a weak point in the wire. When the wire has been tightened up to this point, squish the crimp beads with your pliers. To make sure there is no excess wire between the beads in your finished project, shake all the beads from the loose end down to the finished end, and repeat the crimp-clasp-crimp threading sequence at end two, again hiding the jeweler's wire strand under some of the beads before cutting the excess.

Because it is composed of stainless steel cables, jeweler's wire will kink if bent sharply. Projects strung on jeweler's wire must be stored in open loops – do not throw in a jewelry box or squish in your pocket! – once kinked, it will not go back to normal and the project will need to be restrung.

CHAIN

Beadworld carries a selection of sterling silver, gold filled and base metal chain on spools, sold by the length – as selection and prices can vary, please call for current stock and details.

TOOLS

Our selection of tools includes mid-range and upper end tools, with something appropriate for all skill levels. If you are just getting started, the high end tools may be a bit of an intimidating investment, so we offer the mid-range blue and purple handle tools as well. We do not generally carry lower end pliers, as you can get these at other bead and craft stores, even hardware or dollar stores.

Chainnose pliers (known in other circles as “needlenose”) have a pointed jaw and flat inner surfaces that may be either smooth or rough. Note: our beading pliers do not have a cutter section, as many hardware pliers do. Chainnose pliers are good for making sharp bends in wire, squishing crimp beads, manipulating leather ends, bead tips and jump rings, and holding projects steady for work with other tools. If you are doing wirework, be aware that **rough jaw pliers** will leave marks on your wire, and a smooth jaw chainnose tool may be a better option. Note: **flat nose pliers** have a wider, flatter tip, a smooth jaw, and can be used for many of the same activities as chainnose.

Round nose pliers are your best friend for wirework; they have two smooth, graduated cones, and will make perfectly round curves and loops. Great for making headpin earrings and links, and indispensable for more advanced wirework.

Cutters are crucial for jeweler’s wire and craft wire – either of these will wreak havoc on scissors. Be careful not to use a heavier gauge wire than your cutters can handle, as they will dull quickly and the blades may chip.

Note: the mid-range pliers are available in blue and purple handles – the blue handled pliers are slightly more durable and a little larger; the purple handle pliers are a more delicate tool with smaller handles and working ends, plus a comfortable spring feature so tool automatically reverts to open jaw position.

The critical tool set for working with jeweler’s wire, craft wire, and findings in general is: Chainnose pliers, round nose pliers, and cutters. **Any three \$12.95 blue or purple handle pliers, if bought at same time: \$30 for set**

“Palm grip” pliers are made in Japan, and have longer, narrower jaws than regular pliers. “Palm grip” refers to the circular handle, approximately 3 inches across, with a spring connecting the handle ends. This allows the handle to sit comfortably in your hand, and springs the jaws back to an open position when relaxed – a feature much appreciated by anyone with arthritis or a tendency to develop cramps.

Flush cutters leave less of a point on a cut wire end than semi-flush cutters, but must be kept sharp for maximum effectiveness. Wire end may still need to be filed for absolute smoothness.

Crimping pliers have three sections to the jaw: one, closest to the handle, forms a flattened heart – it is used for the first step, to curve and press the crimp. The second section is a round space, which is used to fold the pressed crimp bead, placed perpendicular (at a 90° angle) to its original position in the first section. The last step is to use the tips of the crimping pliers jaws to squeeze the folded ends of the crimp together, to create a smooth, cylindrical finish.

The **“Magical Crimp Forming Tool”** is designed for use with .019” jeweler’s wire and 2mm tube crimps – it creates a smooth, round “bead” out of the crimp, by pushing the ends of the crimp into the wire but leaving the middle untouched.

Split ring pliers have one end of the jaw hooked in towards the other, allowing the user to grab a split ring between the two loops and force it open. Used extensively for making clasp sets and connections - saves your fingernails!

Bent nose pliers can be useful for getting into small areas between beads and/or clasps, and working with jump rings. Same basic design as smooth jaw chainnose pliers, but with a sideways bend in the jaw 2/3 of the way towards the tip.

Nylon jaw pliers are used for pressing and straightening wire and headpins– just pull kinked wire length between the clamped jaws. Helpful for straightening wire off spools, and making botched wirework projects into useful pieces again.
